Ancient Egypt

History

Term 4 is the start of our exciting topic on Egypt. We will begin to spend time exploring the geographical and historical features of all aspects of Egyptian life. The children will get to partake in exciting activities to understand what happened and how people lived in the Ancient Egyptian times.

Our focus question this term for RE is 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'? The children will be looking at the sacrifices Jesus made and discuss Lent.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at magnets and forces.

We will be experimenting with what materials magnets attracts and the different poles on the magnets. Children will also learn to identify pull and push forces.

There will be two maths tasks set on MyMaths every week. It may help to go through the pre-lesson before doing the task.
