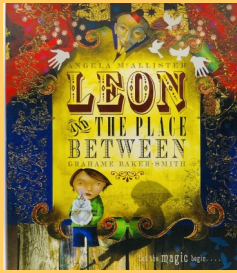


English

Maths

Geography
