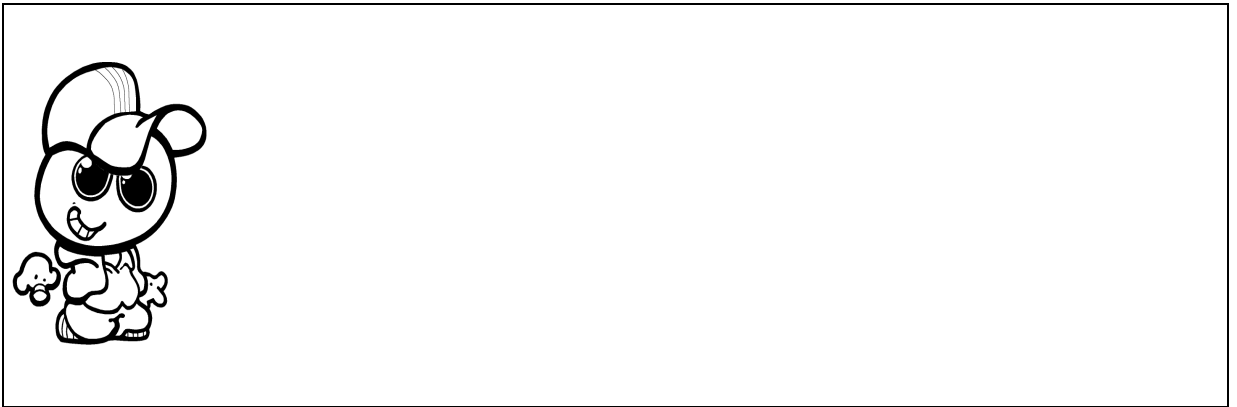

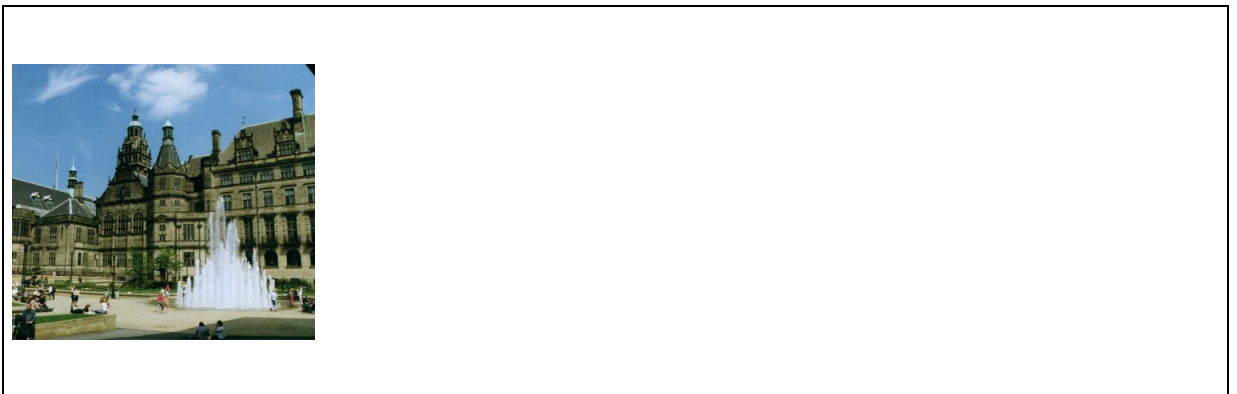

Proper nouns begin with capital letters.

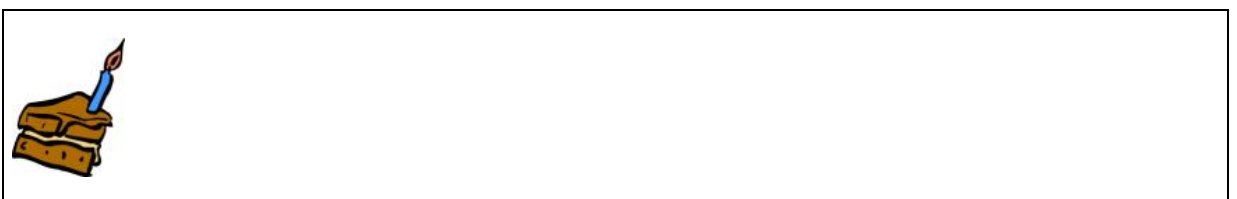
