English

This term, we will be reading **We're going to find the Monster** and looking at instruction
writing.

We will be building up to construct simple sentences and punctuating them correctly.

The children will learn the role and function of lists, labels and captions and will also begin to use adjectives to make their writing more interesting.

Science

We will begin this term by learning about the human body. This will include naming the parts of the body and talking about what they do, understanding which body part is used for each sense and learning how to keep our bodies healthy. We will then start our learning around seasonal changes in 'Autumn'. This will involve looking at evergreen and deciduous trees, studying nocturnal animals, and investigating the best material to wear during the Autumnal weather.

Computing

This term, children will learn how to identify technology, computers main parts and how to use them.

They will also create rules for using technology safely.
