English

This term in English, we will be starting by writing a descriptive story. We will be focussing on basic writing skills such as using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

In Reading, our focus will be reading for understanding and improved fluency, using a variety of strategies to work out unknown words. We will continue to build on the phonics taught in Year 1.

Science

Our topic 'Animals Including Humans' concentrates on keeping healthy. We will be finding out about and describing the basic needs of humans, for survival (water, food and air). The importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene will also be covered. Happy healthy minds will be an important focus of this term.

Computing

The children will learn how to use programmable robots and will begin to understand how to give clear instructions to achieve a set goal.

Online Safety: The children will discuss how to protect their online reputation.
