Extreme Earth

Geography

This enquiry introduces pupils to some key aspects of physical Geography, in particular, one of the major outcomes of tectonic activity in the world – earthquakes. The children investigate the causes and impact of one specific earthquake in one particular location in the world, where earthquakes occur frequently, before looking more widely at global patterns.

<u>R.E.</u>

Our focus question this term for RE is 'What do Hindus believe that God is like? The children will be identifying some Hindu deities and explain what Hinds believe about God.

Science

In Science, we will be recognising that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.

We will be experimenting with how light is reflected from surfaces and recognising that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.

Home Learning

There will be two maths tasks set on MyMaths every week. It may help to go through the pre-lesson before doing the task. We would like children to be play at least twice a week on TTRS and reading every day.

Maths

This term in math, our main focus will be on multiplication and division.

Computing

In Computing, we are exploring the concept of sequencing in programming through 'Scratch'. It begins with an introduction to the programming environment. They will be introduced to a selection of motion, sound, and event blocks which they will use to create their own programs, featuring sequences.
