<b>Key Vocab</b>	
<b>Legions</b>	An army that had around 5000 men.
<b>Legate</b>	The person in charge of the Legion.
<b>Forum</b>	Square in the middle of streets that are used to share news and markets.
<b>Invaders</b>	Invaders are people who use force to enter a place and take over, usually with an army
<b>Settlers</b>	Settlers are people who go to live in a place, with the aim of staying there permanently.

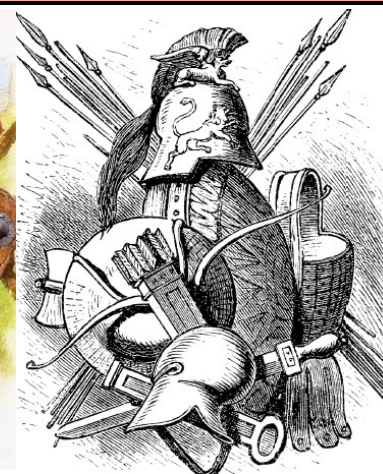
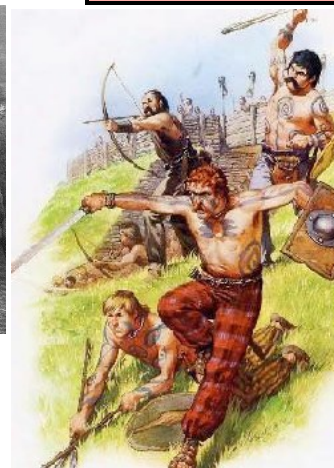
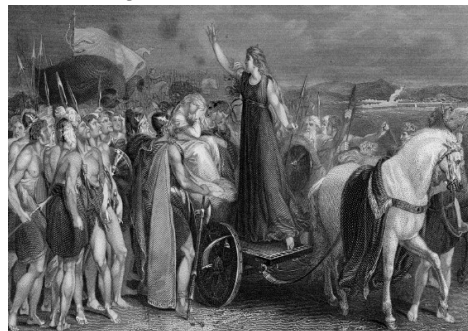

<b>Key people</b>	
<b>Boudicca</b>	The Celtic Queen of the Iceni tribe of modern-day East Anglia, Britain, who led a revolt against Rome in 60/61 CE
<b>The Romans</b>	Romans were a group of people who belonged to the Roman Empire. The city of Rome, in Italy, was the centre of this empire.
<b>Julius Caesar</b>	In the year 55 BC, Julius Caesar was emperor of Rome.
<b>The Celts</b>	The Celts were a collection of tribes with origins in central Europe that shared a similar language, religious beliefs, traditions and culture.
