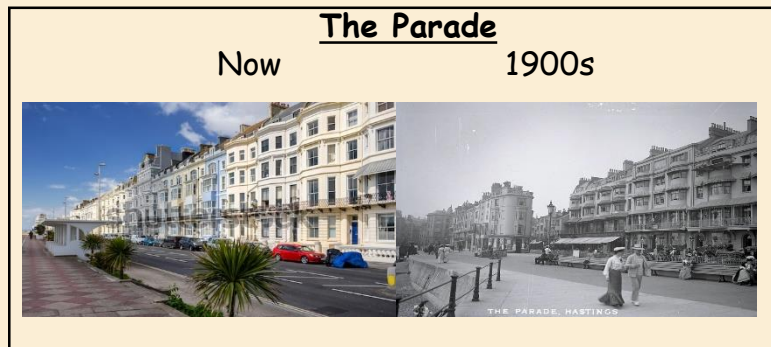


How and why is my local area changing?

<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
location	A place or position.
run - off	Anything that drains away, such as excess rainwater that is not absorbed by the earth.
saturated	To fill or soak completely.
natural disaster	A disaster, such as an earthquake, flood, or volcanic eruption, that is caused by natural rather than human forces.
derelict	Abandoned.
borough	A town that governs itself.
census	An official count of the people who live in a country or other area. A census is also used to collect information about these people, such as their job and age.
demographic	The study of human populations in areas linking to their age and sex.
orbit	The curved path in which a planet, satellite, or spacecraft moves in a circle around another body.
trend	The latest style.
density	How close things are together.
irrigation	The supplying of water to land by man-made means.
deforestation	The act or process of cutting down the trees of a forest.
fieldwork	Scientific research, exploration, or observation conducted in the field rather than the laboratory or classroom.
correlation	A relationship between two or more things.



- Facts and information:**
- After World War 1 a German submarine washed up on Hasting beach.
 - The population of Hastings was 65,528 in 1901. This has risen to 92,855 in 2018.
 - Local areas change for a number of reasons - technology, trade, migration, jobs.
 - Both World Wars affected local areas and change some them beyond recognition.
